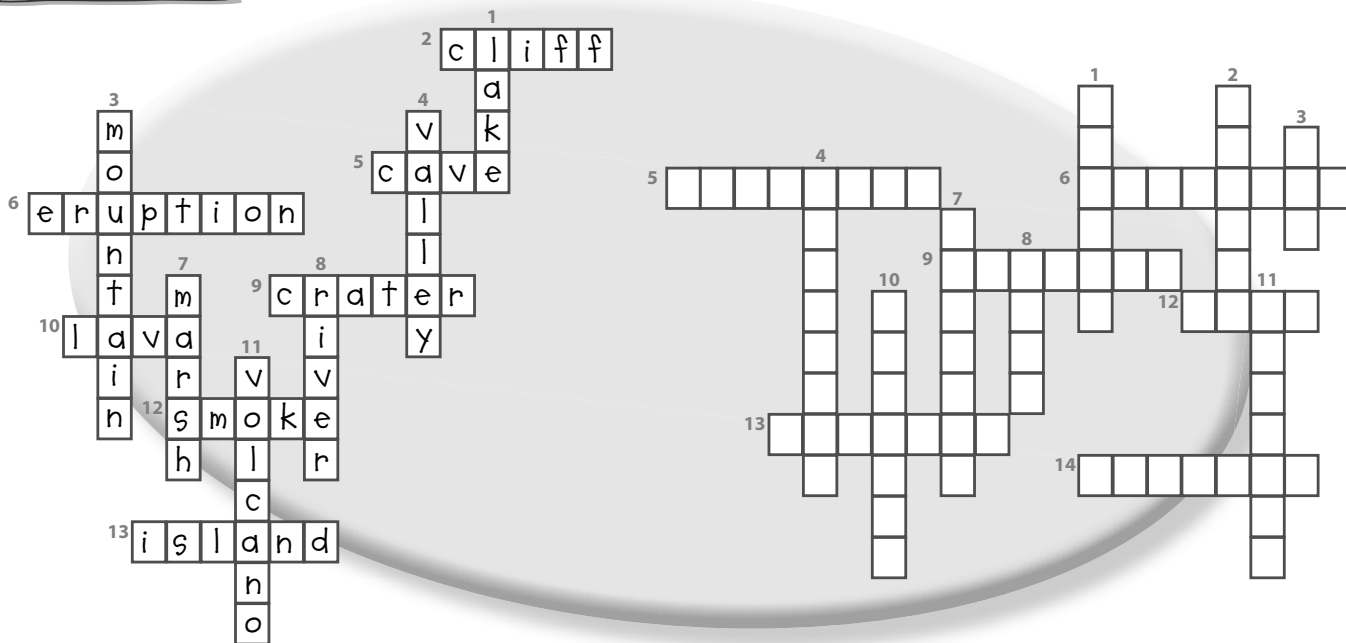

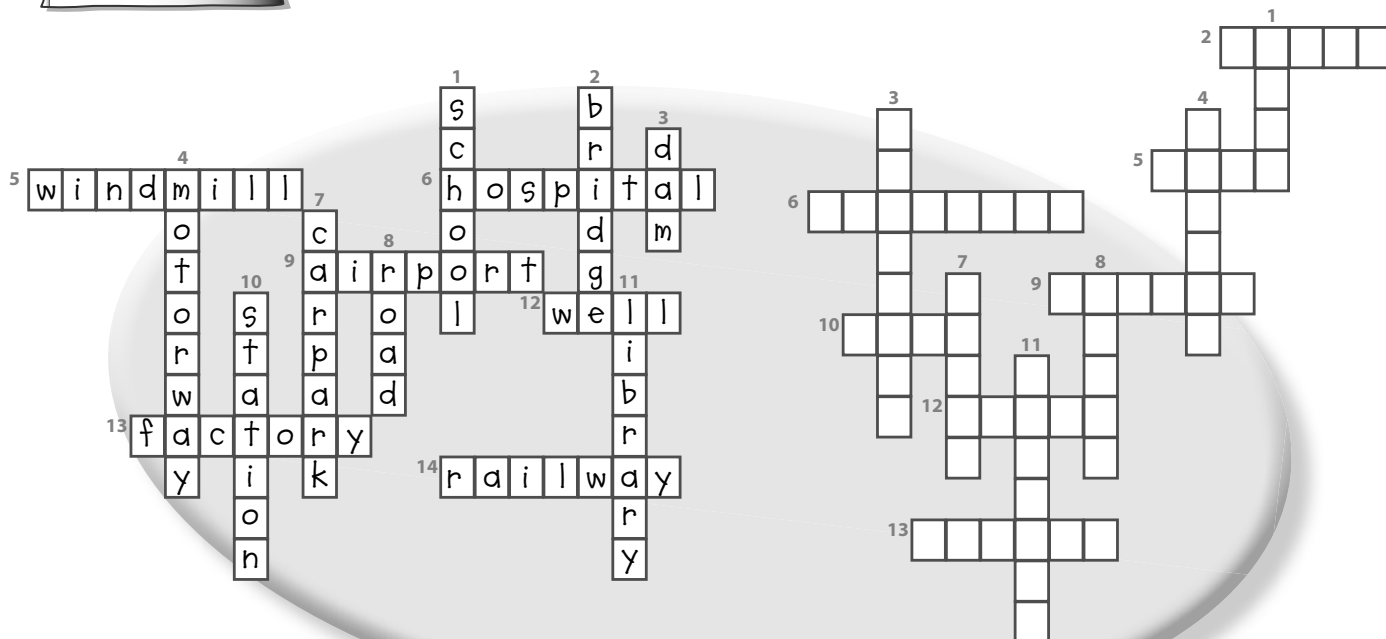

#### Method

 Decorate with slices of lemon.

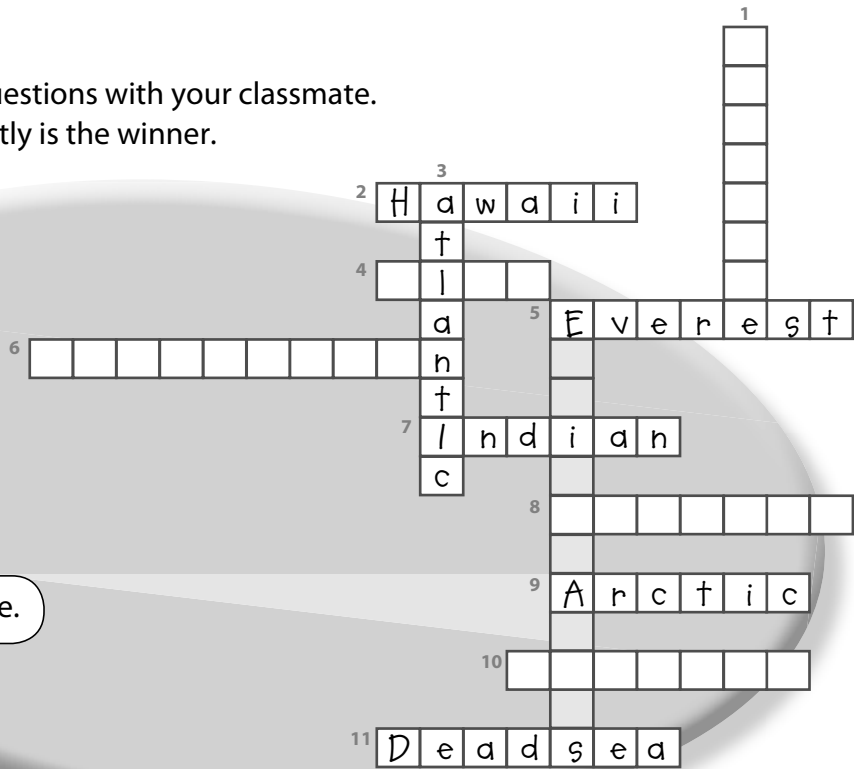

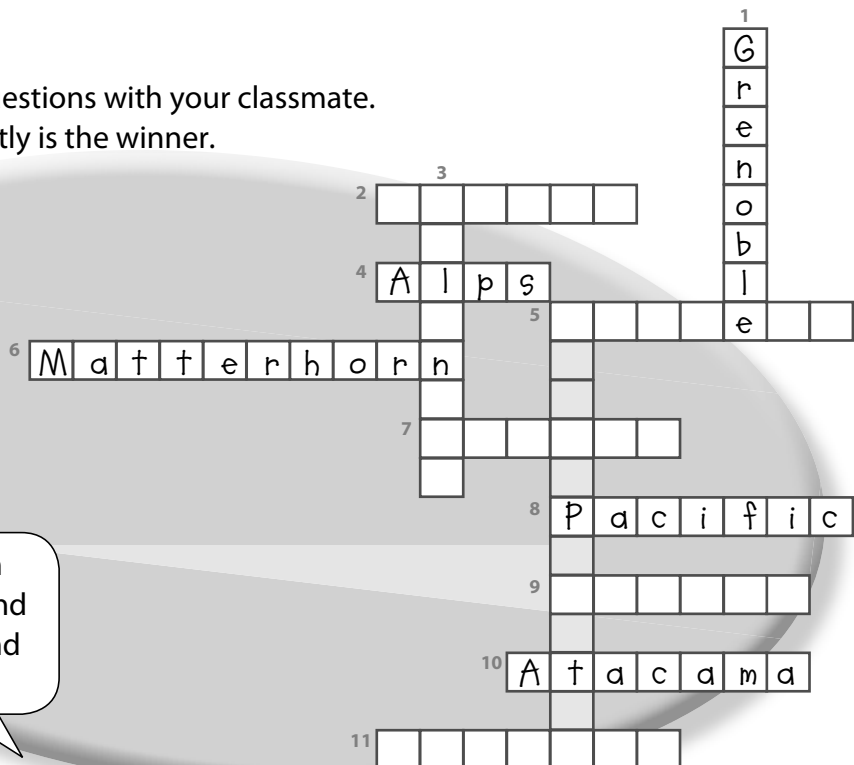
